

After two years filled with creativity, experimentation, and teamwork, the partners of My Diversity, Our Strength gathered together for the final online conference:

#### **Empowering Girls in STEM Through Game-Based Learning**

It was a celebration of everything we've built together and a deep dive into how playful learning can help break gender stereotypes and open new doors for girls in STEM.

During the conference, we proudly presented our three main creations:

- **The Competence Framework**
- **The Compass**
- **The Escape Box**

During the conference, each partner contributed their unique insights on how to select the right skills for designing engaging activities, the rationale behind creating an escape game, and how inclusion is integrated into the game's core.



Additionally, the partners reflected on the project's journey, discussing various topics along the way. Here you have a glimpse:

### Fact checking: why the Gender Gap still exists

We kicked things off with a reality check: across Europe, girls are still vastly underrepresented in STEM studies and careers. The tools created helped us unpack the stereotypes, social expectations, and invisible barriers that contribute to this imbalance.

### Understanding inclusion

We explored what inclusion really looks like, not just as a slogan, but as a practice.

From learning differences to psychological barriers, cultural biases, and accessibility needs, we looked at how young people experience learning in very different ways.

Our takeaway? Inclusion isn't something you add at the end, it's something you build in from the very first idea.

### A small dive into Game-Based Learning

We learnt that games are such a powerful educational tool because...They reduce anxiety, encourage experimentation, while playing it's possible to celebrate mistakes as learning steps, they promote teamwork and communication and have the power to engage even reluctant learners
